

# Setting Up an Infusion

*Products may vary according to your home health company.*

**1.** Clean your work surface.

**2.** Wash or sanitize your hands.


**3.** Gather your supplies.

- Hand sanitizer
- Infusion bag and tubing
- Saline flush
- Infusion pump
- Disinfectant

**4.** Open and set up your supplies.

- Each item is single use. If an item touches anything besides the line once open, discard and obtain a new one.

**5.** Wash or sanitize hands again.



**6.** Disinfect the end of the cap.



OR



- 15 seconds to scrub.
- 15 seconds to dry for alcohol wipe.
- 5 seconds to scrub.
- 5 seconds to dry for Prevanix wipe.

**7.** Attach and flush saline.



- Keep control of the line. Reclean if the cap touches anything. Push and twist the saline syringe onto the cap and unclamp the line. Pulse flush the entire saline syringe. Hold the injection cap firmly. Untwist to disconnect the saline syringe and discard.

**8.** Disinfect the end of the cap.



OR



- 15 seconds to scrub.
- 15 seconds to dry for alcohol wipe.
- 5 seconds to scrub.
- 5 seconds to dry for Prevanix wipe.

**9.** Attach the infusion tubing to the injection cap and unclamp.



**10.** Start your infusion pump as instructed by your home health nurse.
