



Virginia Mental Health Access Program Second Anniversary

The Virginia Mental Health Access (VMAP) Program's psychiatry/psychology consult line is celebrating its second anniversary. Since opening two years ago, VMAP has registered 545 PCPs for the consult line, providing 1,257 consults.

VMAP has launched three [regional hubs](#) in the northern, eastern, and southwest regions of the state and is continuing to expand.


Since many patients may have missed the opportunity to be screened for scoliosis during the pandemic, our **spine program will provide free on-site scoliosis screening and education**. Patients may then schedule formal visits based on their assessments.

Coastal Prosthetics and Orthotics will demonstrate how braces are made and show the latest bracing technology. Local scoliosis support groups and multiple spinal device manufacturers will have booths for additional education.
